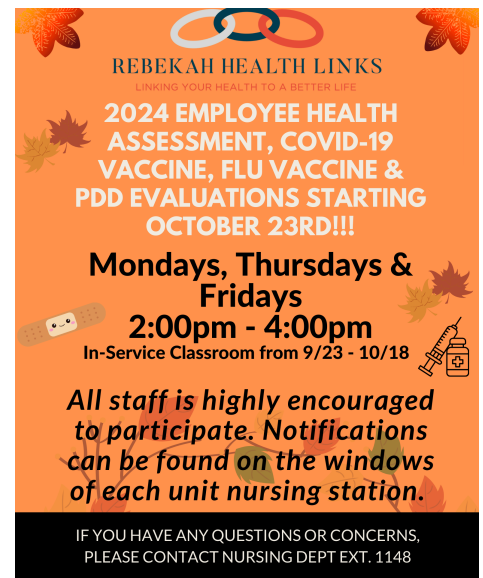


## TIME TO GET SPOOKY!!!
